👉 SEEKING TEN VOLUNTEER INTERPRETERS FOR CEDAR POINT 👈

Each year, during the first week of **August**, the Ohio Association of the Deaf, Inc. hosts its annual **Deaf Awareness Day at Cedar Point**.

During the event, qualified volunteer interpreters are needed for various shows, which will be performed that day at theaters within the Cedar Point compound. Each show is approximately 25 to 30 minutes long; with interpreters being asked to interpret (sign and voice) two or three shows. Interpreters also are used at the Cedar Point Ticket Booth before the start of the event day and after it ends.

REQUIREMENTS:

Each interpreter must:

- Have RID Certification/NAD Level 4 or 5
- Know how to sign songs and be comfortable signing theatrical performances
- Be comfortable signing and voicing for large audiences

*The deadline date each year, for indicating interest in this volunteer position, is the **second Monday of July**.*

Once the interpreters are chosen, OAD will inform each interpreter, and then coordinate the interpreting schedules and assignments for the day. After completing the assigned interpreting duties, each interpreter will have an opportunity to **enjoy Cedar Point free of charge**. In addition to the interpreter having free access to Cedar Point, **one additional free ticket for that day** will also be given to each volunteer interpreter, to share with a family member or friend.
